

Senior Instructor and I/C Health & Safety Job Profile

Adventure *Plus* works with 7,500 young people each year in a positive Christian environment. We are currently working towards the development of an *AdventureBase* which will more than double our capacity, and significantly enhance the quality and expand the range of activities we can offer.

The Senior Instructor and I/C Health & Safety is a crucial part of our team, managing our instructors as well as being responsible for kit storage areas and safety procedures across our activity provision. The Senior Instructor is part of the A+ management team and is the instructors' representative at a management level.

The successful candidate will line manage our instructors, being their first port of call for help and advice and having responsibility for delivering reviews, managing their holiday and agreeing personal development targets.

They will also be responsible for A+'s operational systems, our RBAs and health and safety plans and will oversee our AALS licence and bi-annual inspections.

The successful candidate will be an Event Leader and activity coach modelling high standards of professionalism to our team at all times as they organise and deliver a range of events and activities at the A+ site and across the UK.

Working closely with the training manager, our Senior Instructor will also deliver training courses to our instructor team, Gap Year instructors and external clients. These will be a mixture of in-house and NGB qualifications with the ideal candidate able to deliver and assess Lowland Expedition Leader (LEL3) as well as paddlesport, biking and/or climbing awards.

Most importantly, the successful candidate will be confident to build relationships with young people - inspiring them, building their confidence and equipping them to fully participate in activities; and inviting them back on Total Adventure Holidays.

Management of A+ A+ is broadly divided into four main sections:
 Group Adventures: Our largest section catering for approximately 7,500 children pa
 GAP: The Gap Training Year
 Total Adventure: Adventure Holidays for individuals: 8-12 & 12-17s
 Adventure*Impact*: Specialist activity provision for young people 'at risk'

Each section is managed by a Section Leader.

Section Leaders meet approximately monthly through the year.

There is also a Management Group and a Board of Directors.

Hours: The day starts with a team meeting and morning thought at 08.30 each day. As part of our regular team, you would be expected to lead the morning thought and prayer from a Christian perspective on a shared rota basis.

Qualifications: A strong quiver of outdoor education qualifications including ML, Paddlesport Coach & RCI. A full UK driving license is a requirement of the role.

Holidays: 22 working days per full year worked; 1 extra day per completed 2 years; (to max 5 extra days).

Salary: £24-27,500 depending experience & qualifications, with scope to grow.
