Adventure Awaits...

Welcome to our annual update on encouragements, challenges, and plans for our unique Adventure Youthwork here at A+ and the continued development of the Adventure *Base*, providing life-changing adventures throughout the year for even more children and young people.

It is wonderful to know that, with your help, Phase One of the base is now complete: Affordable, Accessible Accommodation for up to 180 is now in place and much appreciated by schools, youth groups, church communities, and training agencies. So we now turn our attention to Phase 2: Affordable, Accessible Adventure facilities.

We are seeing more young people encouraged in their mental health, some equipped to re-enter mainstream education, others coming to realise that they are greatly loved and highly valued, and some embarking on a faith journey that brings fresh hope and wellbeing into everyday life. The vast majority choose to keep in touch and come to A+ time and again, knowing that they are always welcome.

What an exciting journey for us all!

Plans for Affordable, Accessible Adventure on site include extensive climbing opportunities, a caving trail, low and high team challenges, practical conservation opportunities, and the only inland artificial coasteering course in the UK beside our brand new Adventure Lake: complete with islands for bridge building challenges and camping!

Of all the new adventure facilities, The Lake will transform the site the most. Four acres of water will bring much beauty and refreshment, not least as it reflects the incredible sunsets we often see. The Lake will enable safe watersports year-round, eliminating the need to drive to the river for every session and ensuring we are close to warm showers and hot chocolate.

The 100,000 tonnes of spoil will then become The Hill on the adjacent field, adding further relief and beauty to our very flat site and accommodating a new caving challenge and mountain boarding.

Events have aligned wonderfully to enable us to embrace the challenge of The Lake creation:

- High power electricity lines across the field were removed by SSE – largely at their expense!
- A contractor has offered to dig The Lake and create The Hill at a very reasonable cost.
- A key supporter has offered to matchfund any giving towards The Lake, Hill and coasteering wall project!

We are thankful that these elements are in place and excited to share the plan with our faithful and enterprising supporters, as we gear up for this significant project.



Adventure Impact

Our specialist Youthwork and SEND team

Adventure *Impact* are now working with more young people than ever!

Adventure *Impact* (Aim) has experienced significant growth over the last year. Following a major push before the holidays to organise September placements, we began the year with nine students attending multiple sessions, filling nearly all our available spaces. We are now exploring ways to expand our provision, enabling us to reach more students daily with this crucial programme.

We take referrals from schools, pupil referral units, youth offending services, social care, and other charities or youth organisations. Having four young people to work with each day is an incredible privilege and blessing. Our 15th century stone barn is a welcoming safe space for gathering and learning. Seeing our students attend and enjoy themselves in a place where they feel comfortable is genuinely remarkable. This term, we have been focusing more on AQA UAS awards, which the students choose and then work through to achieve. When they receive their certificates, they are so proud, and we hope they take this new-found confidence and resilience with them back in to school and beyond. Some students struggle with reading and writing so Sara, a colleague, introduced us to a reading programme that has helped her family. It is so rewarding seeing students get

excited about succeeding in something which has been a massive barrier to them in school.

Elizabeth has joined us for an internship after finishing her first year with the Gap team. It has been great to see her get alongside the students and help them unlock their potential. She is an excellent asset to the team and we are excited to work with her over the coming year.

We are thrilled each time an Aim student chooses to join our Total Adventure (TA) camps. We had one student returning for his third year at TA. It is fantastic to see the mature young man he has become since finishing the Aim programme. One of our younger students attended TA Easter and TA Beacon, where he enjoyed spending time with other young people in a fun environment and learned about Jesus' love for him. Another of our students even asked to attend Adventures in Worship despite having no musical experience because he is enjoying our TA holidays so much!

We look forward to welcoming more Aim students to TA in the future, where they can form lifelong friendships and experience God's love.

The Aim team deeply appreciate your continued support and prayers for the Aim students and instructors throughout the year. Your involvement is vital to our mission and we are grateful for it.


